School Uniform

We look forward to seeing your children in their uniform in September. For exact details please refer to the school website.

Points to note

To avoid any confusion please be reminded:

- that all children will need back plimsolls for PE lessons.
- for those children choosing to wear trainers, for outside PE lessons, these must be black only. Similarly if your child chooses to change into trainers at playtime, these must also be black only.

Acceptable jewellery:

- children may wear round silver or gold studs (one pair only) and a watch (black or blue strap)
- Ribbons must be plain navy blue ribbons (no wider than 3cm.) and bobbles or hair bands should also be navy blue.

The reasons for these guidelines is to ensure all children come to school feeling happy, smart and secure and under no pressure to keep up with the latest trends.
