Citizens Advice Halton has just started an exciting new project called Directions which is funded by the ESF and is aimed at helping the unemployed / workless back into work or to improve their job searching etc. and is asking schools in the borough to share the following information with our school community.

The main activity of the project is a four day training programme which will look to build up people's confidence, help them identify their skills and experience and match them to those wanted by employers. Citizens Advice Halton also want to encourage unemployed / workless into voluntary work. They will then offer follow up support on a one to one basis supporting people making job applications, finding course or jobs etc.

Directions is a 4 week training programme for you to:

- learn new skills
- build your confidence
- meet new people
- take time for you
- open up new opportunities in work or volunteering

Covering things like communication, team-working, and skills for volunteering, the training can help you make a change, or find your new direction.

With travel expenses and lunch provided, this 1-day a week programme is for people who are 18+, not working, and living in Halton. If you're on benefits, the programme can count towards the hours of your work search requirements.
