Re: Possible reopening of school to more pupils from June 1st 2020

I hope this letter finds you all safe, well and managing through the daily challenges we all currently face.

It continues to be a very unsettling time for us all, and I appreciate that some of you may have concerns and anxieties around the Government's announcement of the reopening of schools from 1st June for certain year groups i.e. EYFS, Year 1 and Year 6. Please rest assured that we are doing everything we can to make sure we are ready to receive the children, if it is safe for our school to reopen in the coming weeks. However, we are also not going to be pressuring anyone to send their children to school, as you know your child/children and personal situation best.

To make sure we are as well prepared as we can be, we are currently working on an action plan for our possible phased reopening, which will be shared with you as soon as possible, so you are aware what the school's reopening will look like in practice.

To help us plan ahead, and have a clearer picture as to the possible numbers of children returning to school, it would be most helpful if you could kindly confirm if:

- Your child / children will return to school from 1st June
- Your child / children will **NOT** return to school from 1st June
- If you are still undecided at this point
